Scholarships

Financial assistance is an important factor for many students as they decide where and what to study. KCC has a variety of assistance programs, which are awarded based on demonstrated financial need.

Scholarships are available to students enrolled for both UG & PG Degree programs at KCC. The eligibility criteria vary for each Scholarship.

Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded based on criteria that may include academic achievement, community involvement, demonstrated leadership skills and financial need.

KCC is committed to helping students with financial aid. Last year alone, over Rs.12 Lakhs were awarded to students in scholarships and endowments. You might be eligible for one of the following scholarships:

- <u>**Rev. K.C.A. Abraham Scholarship:**</u> An academic scholarship for students who come from homes where parents are working in the Christian ministry, Christian not-for-profit organization, or Christian service work.
- **Esther Abraham Endowment:** A full academic scholarship is given for a student from Polio Home.
- **Indian Heritage Scholarship:** An academic scholarship for children of parent's who have served in the Indian Army, Navy or Air Force.
- **Dr. Mark K. Sripathi Endowment:** An academic scholarship for a female day scholar student desiring to study for the Master of Foreign Trade Program.
- **<u>KCC Sportsman Scholarship</u>**: An athletic scholarship for students who rank in sports at the State and National levels.

All scholarships are granted based on the discretion of the college. Scholarships may be limited.

Scholarship requests must be made in writing and submitted to the KCC Admissions Office - <u>admissions@kcc.edu.in</u> (for Non-NRI Students) or KCC International Admissions Office <u>admissions@vineyard.ae</u> (for NRI Students).

Applying for a KCC scholarship

Identify scholarships and bursaries that you're eligible for

Your completed application will automatically identify any scholarship opportunities for which you meet the eligibility criteria.

KCC scholarships are usually posted at the beginning of each term and, once you have submitted your <u>General Online Awards Application</u>, you will be notified of any new awards. External awards are updated as they are received so it's important that you frequently review the opportunities.

You can apply to any scholarship for which you meet the eligibility criteria. Interested applicants may view the criteria when applying to the specific award.

Letters of reference and supporting documentation

Depending on the requirements, applications often ask for letters of reference from Faculty and / or community members and / or individuals who are familiar with your accomplishments. Applicants should carefully review the application to ensure they are providing the correct information and / or supporting documentation.

Receiving your Scholarship

Your application will be processed in roughly four to six weeks following the application deadline – though the length of time may vary depending on the volume of applications received.

Each scholarship has a set amount of money available to be awarded. All eligible applicants are screened against the criteria and the most qualified applicant is selected. An email will be sent to your KCC email account to inform you whether or not your application has been successful.

If successful, a cheque will be sent to you at the home address you have provided to KCC. Therefore, you should check that all your contact information is up to date in the application form.
